


Now we are making the best of the new situation and show in our spacious gallery exclusively for you what we wanted to present to a large audience in Cologne.


The gallery is and will remain open, all Corona measures are being followed and despite all restrictions we are looking forward to your visit all the more.

- Represented in the collections of the Staatsgalerie and Art Museum Stuttgart, Louisiana Museum, Humlebaek, New Orleans Museum of Art, the Weishaupt Collections, Ritter and Schauwerk








GEROLD MILLER TO 47, 2020 30 x 30 x 2 cm lacquered aluminium

- Scheduled solo exhibitions for the 100th birthday at the Lenbachhaus, Munich and Kunstmuseum, Bonn



GÜNTHER UECKER (1930*)

- World renowned artist and keystone of our Gallery since 1977
- 1988 in the Perestroika/Glasnost period first official museum exhibition of a western artist in the UdSSR
- 2014 ZERO, "Countdown to Tomorrow", Guggenheim Museum, New York
- 2015 Retrospective, Kunstsammlung NRW, K20

MICHAEL WESELY (1963*)

- First exhibition "New York Verticals", 1995 at Walter Storms, photos taken with a Camera Obscura, which has a vertical cut instead of the round lens to the incidence of light.
- Pioneer of the technical development of the extreme "Long term photography"
- Since 1983 extensive portrait series with a 5-8 minutes shutter speed of friends and other artists
- The most famous architectural projects include Potsdamer Platz, Berlin and the 3-year long term photography of the renovation of the MoMA, New York (2002-2004) with 4 cameras from inside and outside
- MoMA solo exhibition 2006



Independent and individual position in contemporary, non-figurative painting



- Most recently at Kolumba, Museum of the Archdiocese of Cologne
- Walter Storms Galerie manages the art property of Karin Girke
